1. Make sure all reels are serviced prior to the Jeffreys league outing in November.
2. The nylon coating on all steel traces to be removed – this will ensure a better pickup on sharks.
3. Owner hook are recommended on smaller traces – Sharpest hooks.
4. “Shake down” slides also recommended – Less burnoffs.

RECOMENDED TACKLE LIST

General

- Light tackle 0.40 line No colour (2 Reels preferably)
- Heavy tackle 0.50 line Any colour (2 reels preferably)
- Gum boots
- Fishing bucket
- Water bucket
- Sharp knife
- Chokka hammer

Sinkers

- Weed eater sinkers (10)
- Teardrop sinkers (15)
- Grapnel sinkers (8)
- Cone Sinkers (15)

Hooks + Swivels

- Owner 4o hooks
- Owner 6o hooks
- Any quality hook 8o (Chemically sharpened or Kendle)
- 3 way swivels number 1, 1o, 2o
- “Shake down” slides

Trace + Leader lines

- 0.60 Maxima Ultra Green
- 0.70 Maxima Ultra Green
- 0.80 Maxima Ultra Green
- 1.00 Maxima Ultra Green (Just for leaders, wind-on leaders can be used)
- 120lb carbon coated wire
- 135lb Bleeding wire (Optional)
- Bait foam

SINKERS

1. Anglers must use cone sinkers on throw baits at all times if possible, grapnel and weed eater sinkers have a chance at frightening off a possible skate pickup.
2. In saying the above, it does not apply to the slide traces – grapnel sinkers have to be used with all non return clips.
3. Rule of thumb is as follows :- Start with cone sinker, if there is drift then change to a weed eater sinker, if there is still drift then change to a grapnel sinker.

LEADERS

1. For scratching, targeting brown skates, small sharks, reef fish – 0.60mm leader
2. When targeting diamonds on the beaches – 0.70mm leader
3. For raggies and sliding traces – 1.00mm leader or wind-on leader

1. NYLON TRACE - 40 / 60 / 80, TARGET SKATES AND EDIBLES



Specifications

- Three way swivel Number 1 (for 40 hook), 10 (for 60 hook), 20 (for 80 hook)
- Hook 40 / 60 / 80
- Maxima ultra green 0.60 (for 40 hook) / 0.70 (for 60 hook) / 0.80 (for 80 hook)
- Bait foam
- Bait : Chokka + Prawn / Sardine / Mackerel

How to Make

- Hook to swivel length 50cm for sandy areas and 30cm for rocky areas
- Add foam to float bait
- Knots : Figure 8 (3 loops)

2. SLIDE TRACE



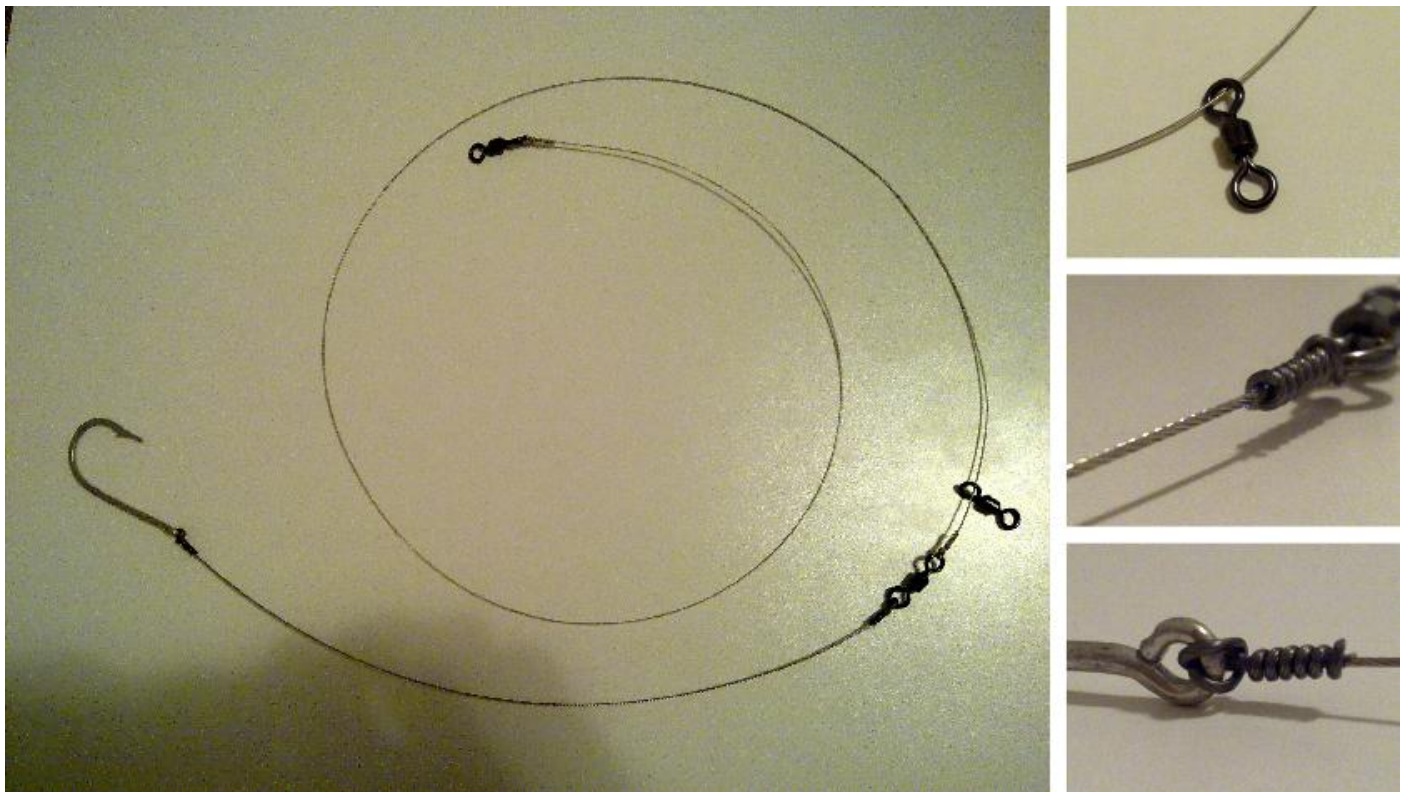
Specifications

- "Shake Down" slide
- Hook 6o and 8o
- Carbon coated 120lb / Bleeding wire 135lb
- Bait : Sardine / Mackerel / Whole Chokka

How to Make

- Hook to hook length 5cm (EYE TO EYE)
- Hook to slide length 50cm
- 10o Hook knot : Figure 8 knot
- 80 Hook knot : Snell knot
- Remove carbon / plastic coating from wire

3. BIG SHARK THROW TRACE – FULL METAL JACKET – LIMITED SLIDING



MAIN	– Full Metal Jacket
RIGHT TOP	– Sliding swivel for sinker
RIGHT MIDDLE	- Power knot with carbon coating taken off wire
RIGHT BOTTOM	– Power knot to hook

Specifications

- Power swivels 10 / 20
- Hook 80 (One or two hooks)
- Nylon / Carbon coated steel 120lb
- Bait : Sardine / Mackerel / Chokka

How to Make

- Hook to swivel length 30cm
- Swivel to swivel length 90cm
- Sliding swivel for sinker
- Hook knots : Figure 8 (3 loops)
- Swivel knot : Figure 8 (3 loops)
- Remove carbon / plastic coating from wire
